This frosted glass spray paint is a pre-mixed ready-to-use paint that is easily applied using a conventional spray gun and dries to a fine smooth texture finish with the look and feel of real satin acid etched glass. They are ideal for use on splashbacks and kitchen or bathroom glass surfaces. It is combination of Acrylic and Polyurethane transparent resins with high durability properties. They are designed to be applied by conventional spray equipment onto a variety of substrates especially Glass including Toughened / Tempered Glass. The products are industrial grade and are chemically curing. They are cured using a catalyst supplied with the product. They achieve excellent scratch and chemical resistance and provide a permanent bond to the substrate surface, especially glass. It is supplied in a translucent finish. They can also be tinted to any colour using CR UT pigments. It can be used internally and externally and is heat and water repellent.
